

A DAY AT EVERGREEN MONTESSORI

- Goal:** To further the development of the whole child (emotionally, socially, intellectually, and physically).
- Objective:** To achieve the goal through a prepared Montessori environment, a Montessori teacher, and through the use of other developmentally appropriate methods and objects.
- 6:30 - 8:00 Arrival of children; fine motor activities, puzzles, books, art, coloring
- 8:00 - 8:30 BREAKFAST
- 8:30 – 9:00 Morning circle time; calendar, weather, Montessori materials presented
- 9:00 – 10:30 Morning work time; children work around the classroom exploring various Montessori materials
- Practical Life:** pouring activities, folding activities, buttoning, tying, etc.
- Sensorial:** color tablets, sound boxes, touch boards, geometric cabinet, pink tower, etc.
- Math:** number rods, counters and cards, golden beads, addition board.
- Language:** tracing letter (learn sounds) on sand paper letters, matching objects with beginning sounds, chalkboard for writing letters etc.
- Science/Culture:** World of Plants and World of Animals activities, puzzle, maps, etc.
- Art:** Painting, cutting (scissors), gluing and coloring
- Music:** Variety of music related games/activities
- 10:30 – 10:45 MORNING SNACK
- 10:45 – 11:45 Gross motor time (playroom, outside, Stretch-n-Grow)
- 12:00 – 12:30 LUNCH
- 12:40-1:00 Calming activities: singing, stories, games, yoga, etc.
- 1:00 – 1:30 Rest time
- 1:30 - 3:00 Advanced Montessori students work on pre-academic skills; language, math, science, sensorial, art
- 3:00 – 3:30 Afternoon circle time including stories and songs; Montessori materials/lesson review
- 3:30 School day ends at 3:30 p.m.
- 3:30 – 3:45 AFTERNOON SNACK
- 3:45 – 6:00 Gross motor activities in the large playroom with cube, small trampoline, tricycles, etc. or outside (weather permitting). Fine motor materials also available in playroom.
