

A DAY AT EVERGREEN MONTESSORI

<u>Goal:</u>	To further the development of the whole child (emotionally, socially, intellectually, and physically).
<u>Objective:</u>	To achieve the goal through a prepared Montessori environment, a Montessori teacher, and through the use of other developmentally appropriate methods and objects.
6:30 - 8:15	Arrival of children; fine motor activities, puzzles, books, art, coloring
8:00 - 8:30	BREAKFAST
8:30	School day begins
8:30 – 9:00	Morning circle time; calendar, weather, Montessori materials presented
9:00 – 10:30	Morning work time; children work around the classroom exploring various Montessori materials <u>Practical Life:</u> pouring activities, folding activities, buttoning, tying, etc. <u>Sensorial:</u> color tablets, sound boxes, touch boards, geometric cabinet, pink tower, etc. <u>Math:</u> number rods, counters and cards, golden beads, addition board. <u>Language:</u> tracing letter (learn sounds) on sand paper letters, matching objects with beginning sounds, chalkboard for writing letters etc. <u>Science/Culture:</u> World of Plants and World of Animals activities, puzzle, maps, etc. <u>Art:</u> Painting, cutting (scissors), gluing and coloring <u>Music:</u> Variety of music related games/activities

11:00 – 12:00	Gross motor time (playroom, outside, Stretch-n-Grow)
12:00 – 12:30	Music
12:30 - 1:00	LUNCH
1:00 – 1:30	Rest time/quiet time
1:30 - 3:00	Advanced Montessori students work on pre-academic skills; language, math, science, sensorial, art
3:00 – 3:30	AFTERNOON SNACK
3:30	School day program ends at 3:30 p.m.
3:30 – 6:00	Gross motor activities in the large playroom with cube, small trampoline, tricycles, etc. or outside (weather permitting). Fine motor materials also available in playroom.
6:00	CLOSED
