7:00 - 8:00	Arrival of children; fine motor activities, puzzles, books, art, coloring

8:30	School day begins
8:30 – 9:00	Morning circle time; calendar, weather, Montessori materials presented
9:00 – 10:30	Morning work time; children work around the classroom exploring various Montessori materials
	Practical Life: pouring activities, folding activities, buttoning, tying, etc.
	Sensorial: color tablets, sound boxes, touch boards, geometric cabinet, pink tower, etc.
	Math: number rods, counters and cards, golden beads, addition board.
	<u>Language:</u> tracing letter (learn sounds) on sand paper letters, matching objects with beginning sounds, chalkboard for writing letters etc.
	Science/Culture: World of Plants and World of Animals activities, puzzle, maps, etc.
	Art: Painting, cutting (scissors), gluing and coloring
	Music: Variety of music related games/activities
